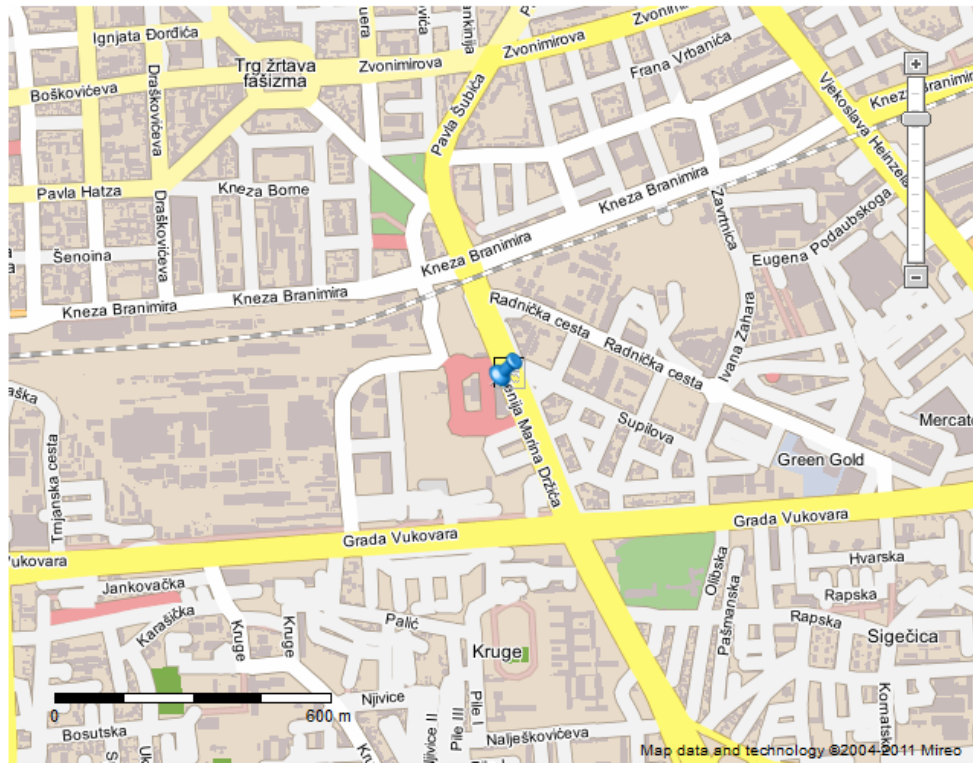
Zadar is located in the region of Dalmacija, approximately 280 km south from Zagreb. You can reach Zadar directly from some major cities in Europe or via Zagreb.

### If you travel from Zagreb to Zadar

Best way to reach Zadar from Zagreb is by bus. Buses operate on two different roads, national road or highway. Bus traveling via highway travels 3,5 hours and it is the most comfortable way to reach Zadar from Zagreb.

### From Zagreb airport to Zagreb main bus station

Airport shuttle operates from Zagreb airport to Zagreb main bus station (the ticket can be bought by the bus driver for ca 5€), where you can catch a bus to Zadar. Zagreb main bus station is located on address Av. Marina Držića 4, Zagreb.

Transport from Zadar airport to Zadar is well organised and it is not expensive.

Trains also operate from Zagreb to Zadar, but it travels almost all night and are **not** to be recommended.
